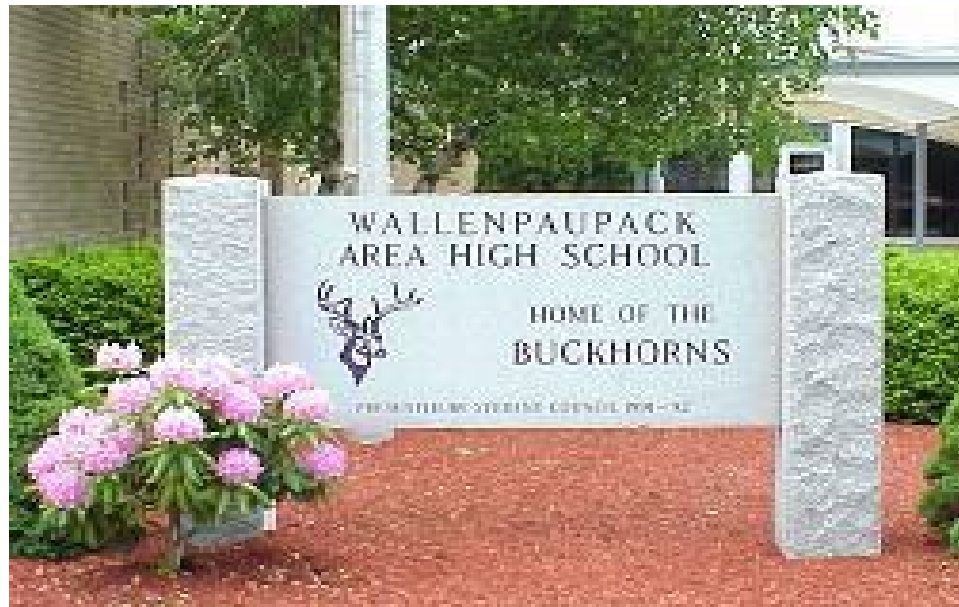

## Graduation Requirements

Minimum **27 credits** for Graduation

English	4 – 1 Credit Courses
Social Studies	4 – 1 Credit Courses
Math	4 – 1 Credit Courses
Science	3 – 1 Credit Courses
Physical Education	3 – Each Course .5 credit
Health and Drivers Education	1 – .5 Credit
Seminar	4 courses - .5 credit each
Electives	8 credits

Proficient score on Keystone/State Assessments –Algebra (8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> grade), Literature and Biology (10<sup>th</sup> grade)

Achieve one of the following:

  - Algebra I (8th or 9th Grade)
  - Biology & Literature (10th Grade)
- Keystone Compositive Pathway
- CTE Concentrator Pathway

- Evidence-Based Pathway

# Academic Coursework

- Prepares students for a variety of post-secondary pathways, including colleges/universities, skilled trades, military service, and the workforce
- Courses are labeled:  
CCR (College and Career Ready), H (Honors), and AP (Advanced Placement)

# Career & Technical Education (CTE)

- CTE Programs of Study prepare students for a wide range of careers
- Provides training and preparedness for industry certifications
- Teaches student critical employability and leadership skills
- Bridges the gap between a rigorous academic schedule and much needed workforce skills

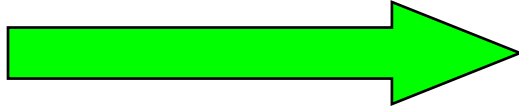
