The 2024-2025 school year will begin
September 3, 2024.

The School Board approved the draft version of the Articles of Agreement for the proposed Wayne/Pike Career and Technology Center. The CTC would be a collaboration between Wallenpaupack, Delaware Valley, Western Wayne and Wayne Highlands to serve students from all four Districts.

Building Updates

South Elementary – Preparing for the upcoming school year and open house to be held September 4th.
North Primary – Holding kindergarten orientation August 26th and 1st and 2nd grade open house on August 28th
North Intermediate – Transitioning into the new year with Open House to be held on August 28th.
Middle School – Students back on campus for the beginning of the Junior High athletic season.
High School – Congratulations to Darby Brennan and Hannah Stratton for FBLA National Championship
Special Education – Extended School Year had about 80 students in attendance for 4 week program

The Board approved an agreement with Wayne Memorial Community Health Centers to facilitate a school based mobile health center which will provide medical care, oral care and behavioral health care to students, families and staff.

Multiple contracts of affiliation were approved to allow students learning experience in clinical settings within the community.

The fall Community Education course offerings were approved. Courses are held within the District and are open to all community members.

Three visitors addressed the School Board to discuss reflection, transparency and recording/broadcasting meetings.

The next School Board meeting will be held on September 9, 2024 in the High School Library.
